Swim Lesson Program Enrollment – Need to Know

What if I miss a class due to illness or emergency?

- Actively enrolled participants who miss a class may make-up in any class of the same level that has openings.
- 1 make-up per session.
- Make-ups must be arranged with the Aquatic Director.
- No credits or refunds will be given for classes not made up.
- Overuse of makeups negatively affects classes. Please honor the spirit of this
 privilege and use it only for illness or emergency.

What if I need to change a class?

 We will gladly accommodate class change requests within the same program and session as long as vacancy exists.

What happens if I need to UN-enroll from a class?

- Credit will be issued if notice is received by the YMCA:
- 1 week or more prior to the start of the program session, a full credit will be given.
- Less than 1 week prior to the start of the session, full credit will be issued, less
 \$3.00 service fee.
- After the start of the session, a prorated credit will be issued based upon the date the notice was received, less \$3.00 service fee.
- Refunds must be approved by the Program Director and Executive Director.
 - Medical conditions may need to be validated by a medical practitioner's written statement.

What about inclement weather or other unforeseen conditions?

- Cancellation of programs is determined by the YMCA.
- When a program is cancelled by the Y due to weather or other unforeseen conditions, the class will be rescheduled, and participants will be notified.
- No refund will be issued for classes missed if you decide not to attend.
